Tax Benefits

The Samaritan House also qualified for the Michigan Homeless Shelter/Food/Bank Tax Credit. To be eligible the donation must be in a form of cash or check. The credit is %50 of the donation up to a maximum \$100 on an individual return or \$200 on a joint return. Please contact your Tax Advisor if necessary.
